## Introduction

**Global Care Foundation** is a Non-Profitable Trust, registered with office of the Charity Commissioner of Mumbai, under the Bombay Public Trust Act 1950. Trustees and Executive Management Body are experience holders and expert in various fields including Socio-Economic, Legal, Educational and Environment etc. GCF is dedicatedly working towards release of Non-Habitual Under-Trails Prisoners, arrested in petty cases and got bail from Honorable Courts but Family is not capable to pay and they are behind the bars for some amount since long time.

After release, we consult them and try to Rehabilitate / Develop their Skills / Assist for Education / Job Placements as per the need and circumstances with collaboration of Prominent NGO's. The main target group of GCF is weaker sections of the society including the Jail Prisoners, Children, Women, Youth, Senior Citizens, Trans-genders and Prostitutes etc.

As per reports, 70% of the convicts are illiterate or have studied only below tenth and fail to realize their rights. We are keen interested to educate / aware Students, Women's, Youth especially about legal issues as well as explain various law topics and their roles while dealing with situations of human rights violations and enlighten them on the critical situations.

## Case Studies

### 1. Released Prisoners

**Shoaib Salim Shaikh (17)** is a Young boy from Mumbra, who lost his father in 2014, Lives with his Family (2 Sisters, Mother and Grand-Mother) at rented apartment. Mother worked as Maid to manage the day to day needs of Family. Due to bad friends circle he engaged in crime and got arrested U.S - 392. Mother was very worried as she doesn't have any option to get his child out because he was under J.J.B (Observation Children's Home, Dongri) since few months. Family condition is very poor therefore she approaches GCF to pay the Cash bail amount so that Child can celebrate Eid-ul-Adha at home. GCF had completed the procedure within two days and Child had celebrated Eid-ul-Adha with his Family. He had promised us to abide all rules and regulations and live a peaceful & honest life as well as try to become a good citizen.

### 2. Released Prisoners

Mazloom a “Dihadi Mazdoor” earns Rs.300 to 400 a day, having 4 sons and 3 daughter's lives in Shelter made at Road side of Bharat Nagar, Bandra. Family condition is so poor that mostly he sleeps on footpath. His son got arrested in 1st week of August U.S – 392, J.J.B had passed order of Rs.10,000 /- Cash bail. Father was helpless and he doesn't want his son future to be built in prison cells. GCF Helped him by providing Cash bail amount and now the Child is at Rehabilitation Center where he is learning to develop his skills and we are assisting him to continue his education.

# Legal & Social Awareness Programs

## 1. Legal Awareness Program for Trans-genders

Global Care Foundation had taken an initiative for organizing a Legal Awareness Program for Trans-gender community with the collaboration of Mumbai District Legal Services Authorities, at Bandra (w). The program was based upon the Legal Rights and Government Facilities / Schemes. It was a successful event and around 100+ people from same community had joined the session and got benefitted with open Question Answer session to know the solutions of their problem.

Our aim is to help this community in Education and Empowerment as well as clear their negative image from society. We wish to conduct more such seminars to clear the gender wise discrimination / oppression.

## 2. Mat Distribution at Children's Observation Home

More than 300 Children's are staying in Observation Home, Dongri. Due to Unavailability of Mats, children's use to sit on ground / floor and had their meals as well as renovation work is going on which creates dust by which dresses, body and environment is unclean which may be hygienic for their health. Therefore Superintendent of Observation Home requested us to donate Mats for the same.

Within a week we had facilitated the mats, Children's as well as Officials are very thankful and Authorities gave us Appreciation Letter for this Good cause.



## Occasional Activities

### 1. School Kit Distribution



As we are aware that in Slum Area, People cannot afford the Educational Expenses which is one of the reason for taking step back from Education and it creates high ratio in illiteracy. GCF had taken an initiative by distributing School Kits to more than 100 Poor Students at Mandala, Mankhurd on 1st August 2018.



The Kit contains all the necessary items required in schools, Viz. Stationary's, Notebooks, etc.

### 2. Food Distribution Drive



In the Last week of August 2018, More than 800 homes had been demolished at Nagwadi, Chembur, due to illegal construction at Govt. Property. Approx. to 150 Poor and Needy Families were still homeless and hunting for Food, Clothing & Shelter. Children, Women's were staying & sleeping in open area without any cover. Therefore by the Support of Well-Wishers and GCF Team, we had distributed Food Packets to Needy and Homeless Peoples on 5 different days. 1800+ Food Packets is been Distributed and Temporary Plastic shades and blankets for 15 Family is served.

### Case Studies

A Family with 8 members (3 son + 3 daughters) living in Wadala, Mumbai at rented place. Father (Taxi Driver) was only the earning Person who was under treatment since mid of August for Tuberculosis (T.B) in KEM Hospital. Family condition is very poor, Children's use to sell leaves and Earn Money as it was the time of Eid-ul-Azha. GCF had helped them by providing One Month Complete Rashan and Medicines as well as paid their Room Rent.

Expected duration of Treatment is 3 - 4 Months.
