Areas of Intervention

Our Focus areas are releasing Non-Habitual Under-Trial Prisoners by providing Legal and Financial Aid and after their release assisting them with counselling, rehabilitation and skill development. Providing free legal guidance to people in need of assistance through Legal Aid Clinics. Conducting Legal / Social Awareness Programs for the public at large and Organizing Para-Legal Training Programs.

We have a team of committed professionals including Advocates, Doctors, Counselors, Psychiatrists, etc. who work wholeheartedly towards furthering our cause.




REUNITING A MOTHER WITH HER NEGLECTED CHILDREN

Mubina Firoj Shah (F, 40) was arrested on 31st March 2019 and spent almost 7 months in Thane Jail. She is a widow who was accused of kidnapping and got arrested along with her minor daughter U/S 363 A, 365 of IPC. Her 10 year old son was left extremely neglected and found it difficult to survive while she was behind the bars. Mubina's cash bail amount was Rs. 20,000. GCF studied her case, and after taking the pitiable state of her son under consideration, decided to pay her bail amount and get her released on bail. We are in the process of getting her daughter released too.

OUR NOTEWORTHY CASES

Haider Ali (M, 19) a college dropout, worked in a water supply job. One day he got into an argument with a police that escalated to a fight. He was arrested on 15th March 2019 and spent over 7 Months in Arthur Road Jail. He was the sole earning member of the family and after his arrest, his mother found it very difficult to manage the day to day needs of the family. They shifted to Titwala as she could no longer afford the rent of their residence. GCF arranged for the young boy's bail amount of Rs. 16,000 and released him on bail. After his release, we counselled him, he is now ready to continue his education. He will also join a skill development center.

Manisha Gaikwad (M, 30) a house keeper, was unfortunately arrested along with her fellow housekeeper who committed a robbery in the hotel that they worked in. She was charged u/s 380, 411, 454 of IPC. Her three young kids were left neglected and distraught as her husband could not cope with earning and looking after them. She was granted bail, but her husband with his measly wages could not afford to pay the bail amount of Rs. 10,000. GCF assessed and studied her case and decided to provide her financial aid in the form of bail money. After spending 3 months in prison, Manisha, with the help of GCF's intervention, is now out on bail.

Note: After their release, all the aforementioned releasees underwent Counselling. GCF in the process of assisting them with suitable Skill/Skill Development Trainings and will also help rehabilitate and re-integrate them back into the society.

**DOOR-TO-DOOR CAMPAIGN
IN DAHISAR**

In observance of National Legal Services Day 2019, Mumbai Suburban District Legal Services Authority in association with Global Care Foundation and Thakur Ramnarayan College of Law, Dahisar, organized a two weeks door to door survey campaign to create awareness about NALSA schemes and collect demographic details of the residents of Rawalpada, Dahisar.

This campaign was undertaken as per the guidance of NALSA. 120+ PLVs / Law students of Thakur Ramnarayan College of Law were on field for two weeks and covered approximately 10,126+ households in Rawalpada largest slum located in Dahisar (E), Mumbai.



WHY THE CAMPAIGN ?



To create awareness amongst people about the various NALSA schemes



To determine Educational, Health, Infrastructural and other facilities being provided in the area



To identify major crimes and mitigate criminal activities by understanding the root causes for the same



To find out the number of residents not having basic documents

After data collection and analysis by GCF, the Survey Report containing the detailed analysis and recommendations will be shared with the relevant authorities and stakeholders.

Global Care Foundation will try to coordinate with the concerned authorities and ensure that the recommendations are implemented. GCF will also render suitable Legal and Financial Aid to the residents as required.

SOCIO LEGAL AWARENESS SESSION

at Anjuman Khairul Islam, Teacher Training College, Kurla

Global Care Foundation and DLSA Mumbai Suburban organized an Awareness Session on the topic 'Evils of Social Media' at Anjuman Khairul Islam Teachers Training College, Kurla on 21st November 2019. About 60+ female D.Ed students attended this Session. Renowned psychiatrist Dr. Nahid Dave spoke on the topic Social and Psychological impact of Social Media, while the distinguished Advocate Trupti Patil discussed the Different types of cyber-crimes and their legal aspects.

The speakers also answered students' queries. The students were made to take a quiz on cyber-crimes, the average score of which came to 60%. The teachers and attendees gave a positive feedback about the stimulating session.

30+ Law Students of the College and several DLSA and GCF staff members briefed the commuters about various Legal aspects with respect to Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, The Railways Act and Maintenance & Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act. The commuters were also informed about the various schemes provided by DLSA.

400+ commuters benefitted from this three-hour awareness campaign. GCF aims to conduct many such similar events in future.





SOCIO LEGAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME

at Valia College, Andheri.

Global Care Foundation, in collaboration with Mumbai Suburban District Legal Services Authority, organized a socio-legal awareness programme at Valia College, Andheri (Mumbai) on 11th December, 2019.

Advocate Shahnawaz Pathan spoke on the topic 'Crime and Youth'. He spoke about how youngsters today often overlook the petty offences (which are also crimes) that they commit during different phases of their lives, the kind of crimes that the youth of today commit and the responsibility that the youth have towards society. Dr. Nahid Dave spoke about the 'Evils of Social Media'. She highlighted the negative impact that social media has on the human psyche, the staggering amount of time that people spend online, how Social Media is as addictive as drugs and how Social Media addiction will soon be classed as a Disorder.

The College authorities thanked GCF and the speakers for this insightful and informative awareness session that saw an attendance to the tune of 115 students.

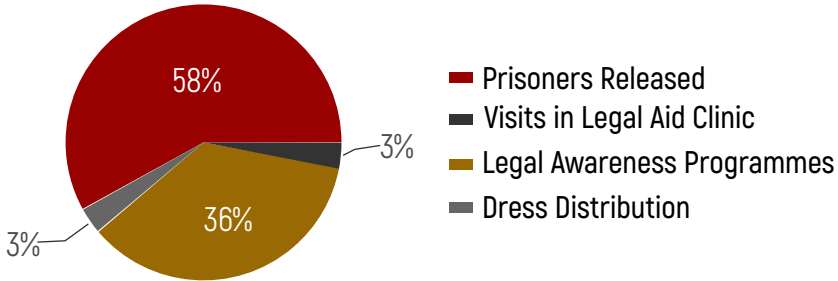
