Our Focus areas are releasing Non-Habitual Under-Trials accused of petty crimes by providing Legal and Financial Aid, and after their release assisting them with counselling, rehabilitation and skill development, Conducting Legal/Social Awareness Programs for the public at large, providing free legal guidance to people in need of assistance through Legal Aid Clinics, and organizing Para-Legal Training Programs. We have a team of committed professionals including Advocates, Doctors, Counselors, Psychiatrists, etc. who work wholeheartedly towards furthering our cause.

## Noteworthy Cases Of The Quarter

**Rizwan Shaikh\***, (28,M), an orphan, lived in Bhayander and did odd jobs to make his ends meet.

He had a fight with his neighbour and a case was registered. Since he had no family, he was languishing in jail and had left hopes to become free again. He had surrendered to his fate and had thought that he would breathe his last in the jail itself.

He had gotten bail through legal aid but still had no means to furnish cash and release himself.

When GCF learned of his plight, Global Care Foundation paid **Rs. 10000** for the cash bail and got him released from Thane jail.

**Manisha Tayde\***, (40,F), a resident of Ambivali lived with her husband in a chawl there. Both husband and wife worked as rag pickers for survival.

While working they stumbled upon some metal which they thought could be of use to them and picked it up. Later, both were arrested and Manisha was lodged in Kalyan jail while her husband was put in Taloja jail.

They had secured a bail order but no one was there to help them. Upon learning of the case, GCF

connected with her daughter and son-in-law residing in Nashik who were keen to get Manisha released. Global Care Foundation paid **Rs. 15000** of the bail of Rs. 25000 and the remainder was paid by the son-in-law. Manisha was released from Kalyan jail after **1.6 years**.

We are in the process of releasing Manisha's husband as well.

# OUR ACTIVITIES

## Noteworthy Cases Of The Quarter

**Sachin Thorat\*** (46,M) & **Rohit\*** (23,M), father and son, lived in shanties of Malad with their family. While Sachin worked as a driver of garbage collection vehicle, his son Rohit, worked as a sweeper.

Rohit fell in love with a 17-year-old girl in the vicinity and since her mother did not approve of their relationship, the mother filed a case on Rohit and his father.

Sachin's wife and daughter were forced to work as domestic helps in order to make ends meet.

Both Sachin and Rohit got favourable bail orders but since the family was in financial shambles, they could not be released. Upon GCF's intervention, both were released from Thane jail, one following the other after spending almost **2 years** in jail.

Global Care Foundation paid **Rs. 16000** for both Sachin and Rohit for the cash bail.

**Release of husband and wife arrested for squabble with the neighbours**

Happiness on his release since he was unwell in the jail and needed immediate medical help.



**Naeem Ansari\*** (22,M) & **Shama\*** (22,F), husband and wife, a resident of Malvani slums got into a squabble with his neighbour. The ladies also got into the fight and a case got registered on Naeem and his wife Shama were arrested and lodged in Arthur Road jail and Byculla jail respectively.

While Naeem worked as an auto driver, Shama was a housewife and they lived with their two little children. Naeem is the sole breadwinner of the family.

With no one to help them, they kept languishing in jail despite having a

favourable bail order.

When GCF learned of the case, a few relatives agreed to come forward to help the distraught couple. Global Care Foundation paid **Rs. 20000** for Naeem and **Rs. 15000** for Shama while Rs. 15000 was contributed by the relatives. They both were released after **10 months** of stay in the jail.
