Our Focus areas are releasing Non-Habitual Under-Trials accused of petty crimes by providing Legal and Financial Aid, and after their release assisting them with counselling, rehabilitation and skill development, Conducting Legal/Social Awareness Programs for the public at large, providing free legal guidance to people in need of assistance through Legal Aid Clinics, and organizing Para-Legal Training Programs. We have a team of committed professionals including Advocates, Doctors, Counselors, Psychiatrists, etc. who work wholeheartedly towards furthering our cause.

Noteworthy Cases Of The Quarter

Faiyaz Qureshi* (26,M), hailing from a poor locale of Mumbra, lived with wife, mentally ill daughter and younger sister.

Faiyaz survived through selling fruits and had his finances troubled.

For his personal use, he purchased a mobile phone. As claimed by him, little did he know that he had purchased a stolen mobile phone.

He was arrested and lodged in Byculla jail. Since he was in jail his family did not have anything to eat for a couple of days until they reached out to Global Care Foundation for help.

Faiyaz had obtained a favorable bail order of **Rs. 15000** which was paid by Global Care Foundation and he was released within 8 days of his arrest.

While he was in jail a monthly rationing kit was delivered to his house so that his family would not starve.

Sukhbir Singh*, (39,M) was arrested in 2015 from slums of Santacruz along with several other people in the area because of a fight that occurred between two groups leading to the loss of a life from the other group.

Sukhbir lived with his cousins when he was arrested. All his co-accused were released on bail at different intervals, while Sukhbir only hoped that he would one day get free.

When Global Care Foundation learnt of his plight, his family was tried to be traced only to find out that the cousins had shifted from the locality several years ago.

Global Care Foundation paid **Rs. 15000** for his cash bail and he was released from Arhtur Road jail.

He needed his documents to be created as well as a job for survival for which he got help from our office.



Noteworthy Cases Of The Quarter

Azeem Khan* (43, M) worked as a technician offshore. He lived alone since his wife left him and his mother lived with his other brothers. Azeem worked as a part time driver. His employer had to deliver a SUV car to a client in Gujarat which Azeem's friend said he would do it.

Azeem gave him the car but to his shock the friend fled with the car and is still untraceable. Azeem was arrested and lodged in Thane Jail. He obtained a surety order which was then modified and reduced after two applications.

Global Care Foundation helped Azeem for his release by paying cash bail of **Rs. 15000** as no one from his family was in a position to help him. He spent around 5 months in jail.



HE SAID

I spent such a long time in jail even after the I was let free. We poor people do not know the law. GCF came to me when I had lost all hopes.

Sunil Rao* (37, M), a resident of Rabale, Navi Mumbai shanties, was acquitted in a case of organised crime in 2018.

The state went in appeal in the Hon'ble High Court and being unaware he did not attend the court dates and a non bailable warrant was issued against him in 2019.

He got a favourable bail order in 2019 itself but he could not arrange for the surety due to poor family background.

A reduction application was made which was granted. Global Care Foundation intervened in the case and paid **Rs. 25,000** towards his bail and got him released from Arthur Road jail after **4 years**.

Workshop for judges on Cyber Security & Forensic Science

Mr. Abid Ahmed Kundalam, Founder & Managing Trustee, Global Care Foundation informed the audience about how they can avail legal aid as well as the services Global Care Foundation can offer them.

After the program, one to one counseling was done with 17 inmates who requested for their bail.

The inmates felt a sense of relief on learning of their rights along with GCF services.

Alibaug District Prison Workshop for Mehendi and Make-up for female inmates

A hands-on Workshop for Mehendi and Make-up was organised by Global Care Foundation for the female inmates of Alibaug District Prison.

This workshop was conducted by Mrs. Samira Furkan and Mrs. Farhana Makdiya, who taught the female inmates how to make mehendi cones, apply mehendi design and basic makeup skills.

Dry mehendi powder and other items necessary for packing mehendi cones was provided to the female inmates so that the cones made by them can be sold in Alibaug Market and the sale proceeds will be given to the inmates on their release from the jail. This workshop shall enable the female inmates to find a job or be self-employed after they are released from jail.

Alibaug District Prison's Superintendent Shri. Ashok Karkar thanked Global Care Foundation heartily along with the resource persons to have arranged the workshop.



KES Shri JHP Law College students' visit to Children Observation Home, Dongri

Global Care Foundation organised a field visit for 50+ law students from KES Shri Jayantilal H. Patel Law College at the Children Observation Home, Dongri.

The students were explained and informed about the functioning of the Children Observation Home as well the Juvenile Justice Act while they were taken to the various places within the Observation Home.

The students went home enlightened with several new things added to their knowledge pool.



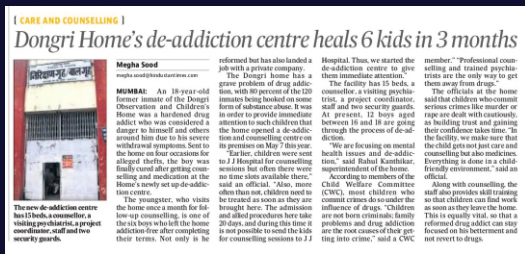
MILESTONE UPDATES

Some inmates at Yerwada jail become mental health guides

Mumbai Some inmates at Yerwada jail have become mental health guides, helping other inmates with mental health issues. The initiative was launched by the Maharashtra State Prisoners' Welfare Board. The guides are trained in basic mental health first aid and are available to provide support to inmates who are struggling with mental health problems. The board aims to reduce the stigma associated with mental health issues and provide a support system for inmates. The guides are also trained to identify inmates who may be at risk of self-harm or suicide and to provide them with immediate assistance. The initiative is a part of the board's efforts to improve the mental health of prisoners and provide them with the necessary support and care.
