## NOTEWORTHY CUSTODIAL STATISTICS

- Number of prisons increased from 1319 in 2021 to 1332 in 2023
- Approximately 72 percent of prisoners are undertrials out of 5.3 lakh prisoners
- Muslims (19.7%), SCs (20.7%), and STs (10.8%) make up 51.2% of undertrials, despite comprising ~39% of the population.
- Release of undertrials has decreased by 1% between 2022 and 2023
- Muslims constitute 34% of detainees and 18.5% of undertrial prisoners.

# VOICES OF THE RELEASED

## Yasin Shaikh\*

In Custody: 4 months | Observation Home, Dongri

Yasin Shaikh landed in conflict with the law while trying to protect his younger sister who was repeatedly being harassed by a boy from the neighborhood. Yasin went to confront him, but things escalated into a fight and the boy succumbed to his injuries.

*"Hamara beta apni behen ke haq ke liye hi gaya tha, par jhagda ho gaya. Global Care Foundation ki madad se aaj mera beta ghar par hai."*

## Rukaiya Shaikh\*

In Jail: 10 months | Byculla Women's Prison

Rukaiya Shaikh, a poor mother living on the streets, was offered shelter by a woman involved in the flesh trade. During a police raid, Rukaiya was arrested even though she had no involvement.

*"Main apne bachche ke saath rehna chahti thi. Mujhe nahi pata tha ki aise bhi kuch ho sakta hai, par Global Care Foundation ne meri madad ki aur ab main nayi zindagi shuru kar rahi hoon."*

## Mahesh Thakur\*

In Jail: 6 months | Thane Central Prison

Mahesh lived with his wife and 4 children in a small room. After falling sick with TB, he could no longer work properly and struggled to pay rent. One day, out of desperation, he stole battery wires from a bus.

*"Main bas apne parivaar ka sahara banana chahta tha. Meri majboori mujhe jail tak le jaayegi, lekin Global Care Foundation ne meri madad ki. Ab main ek chhoti chai ki dukan chalata hoon."*

## Imran Khan\*

In Jail: 6 months | Taloja Central Prison

Imran Khan, a resident of Malad, was jailed after a verbal heated exchange with a woman in traffic, who later called a group that attacked him with a knife during Ramadan. Despite being injured while defending himself, the attackers filed a complaint first, leading to his arrest.

*"Ramzan ke din the, mera beta Imran sirf iftari lene gaya tha, par kuch logon ne use fasaa diya. Global Care Foundation ne aage badhkar madad ki humaari aur use jail se bahar nikalwaya"*

## ⦿ Legal & Social Awareness Program


Conducting Legal/Social Awareness Programs for the public at large especially for Students, Women, Elderly people, Trans-genders and Sex-workers etc.

## ⦿ Project SATHI


Peer led counselling through Mental Health Facilitators created amongst the prisoners who can help alleviate the mental health problems of their fellow inmates.


## OUR FUNDAMENTALS

Social work is a noble cause and our aim is to work at grass roots levels rather than project hypothetical plans. With the intent of working towards a crime free society, our primary focus is providing Legal and Financial Aid to the underprivileged.

We perform with due commitment under the scrupulous supervision of experts from various fields, since we believe that they have the ability to overcome the hurdles and problems at hand with unique and creative solutions.

An idle mind is a devil's workshop. In order to prevent the youth and the next generation to fall into the traps of various crimes, we aim to model the students and youth into responsible citizens of tomorrow.

We function in a transparent manner and wish that people at large support us in our quest of penetrating through society to identify and help the needy and indigent seeking legal and financial aid.





## FOUNDER & MANAGING TRUSTEE'S MESSAGE

The main intent to start Global Care Foundation was to explore the world of crime prevention as I felt great lacking in the society as to Legal Aid and Awareness. I observed that not many are sensitised in this domain and took upon myself to venture into the least worked upon area.

The lack of appropriate legal guidance and awareness has caused a huge population, especially belonging to minorities, who are underprivileged and downtrodden land up in jails.
